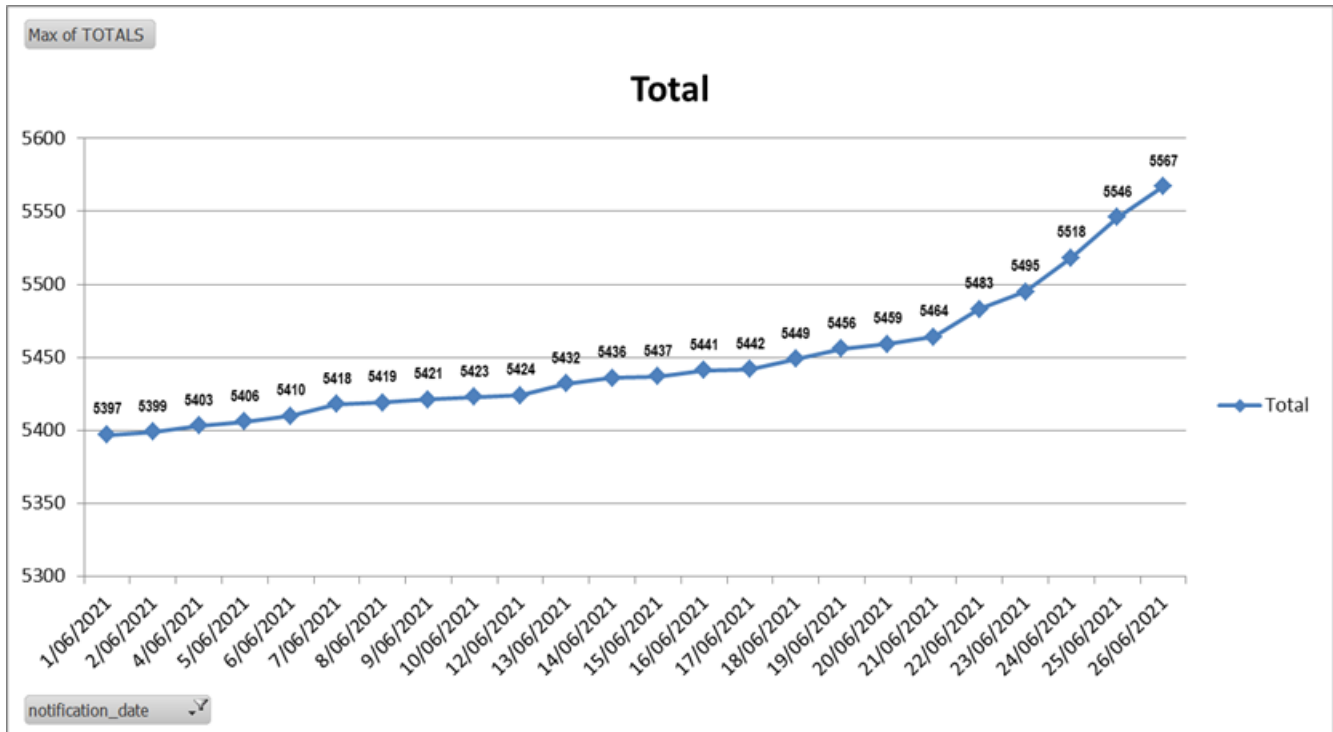


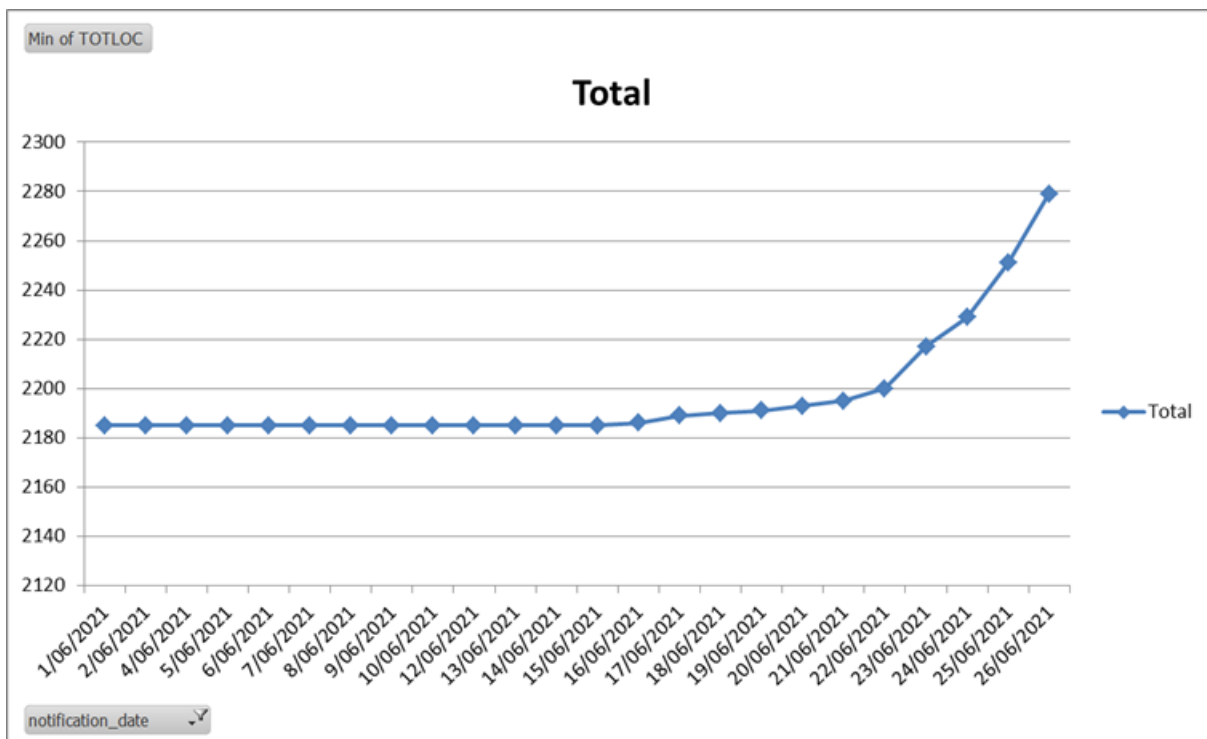
## NSW Cases per Location Analysis as of 28th June 2021

### NSW Total Cases



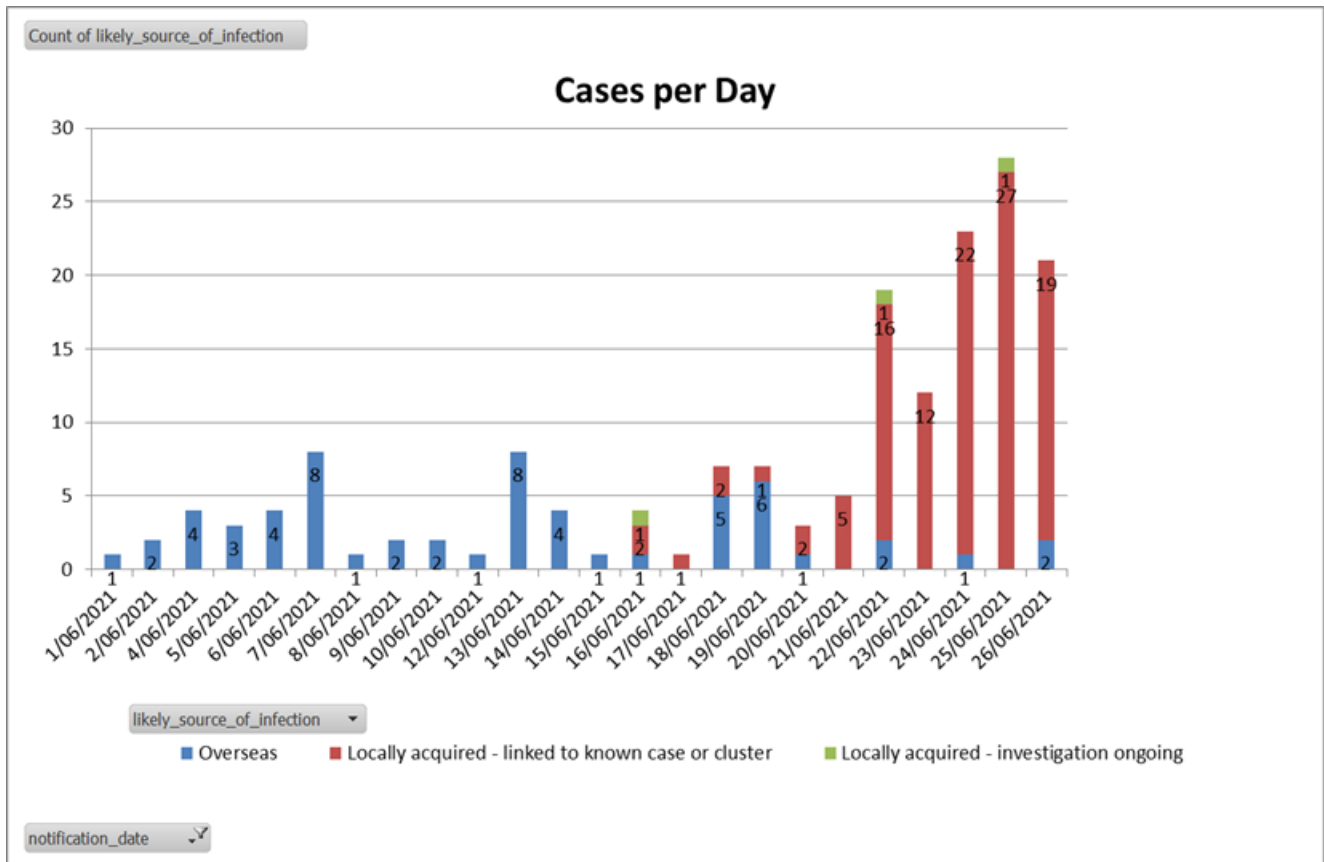
- NSW Health reported that the state had 21 locally acquired cases on 26th June via their data ; *but reported 30 to the press (?)*

### NSW Totals of Locally Acquired Cases ONLY

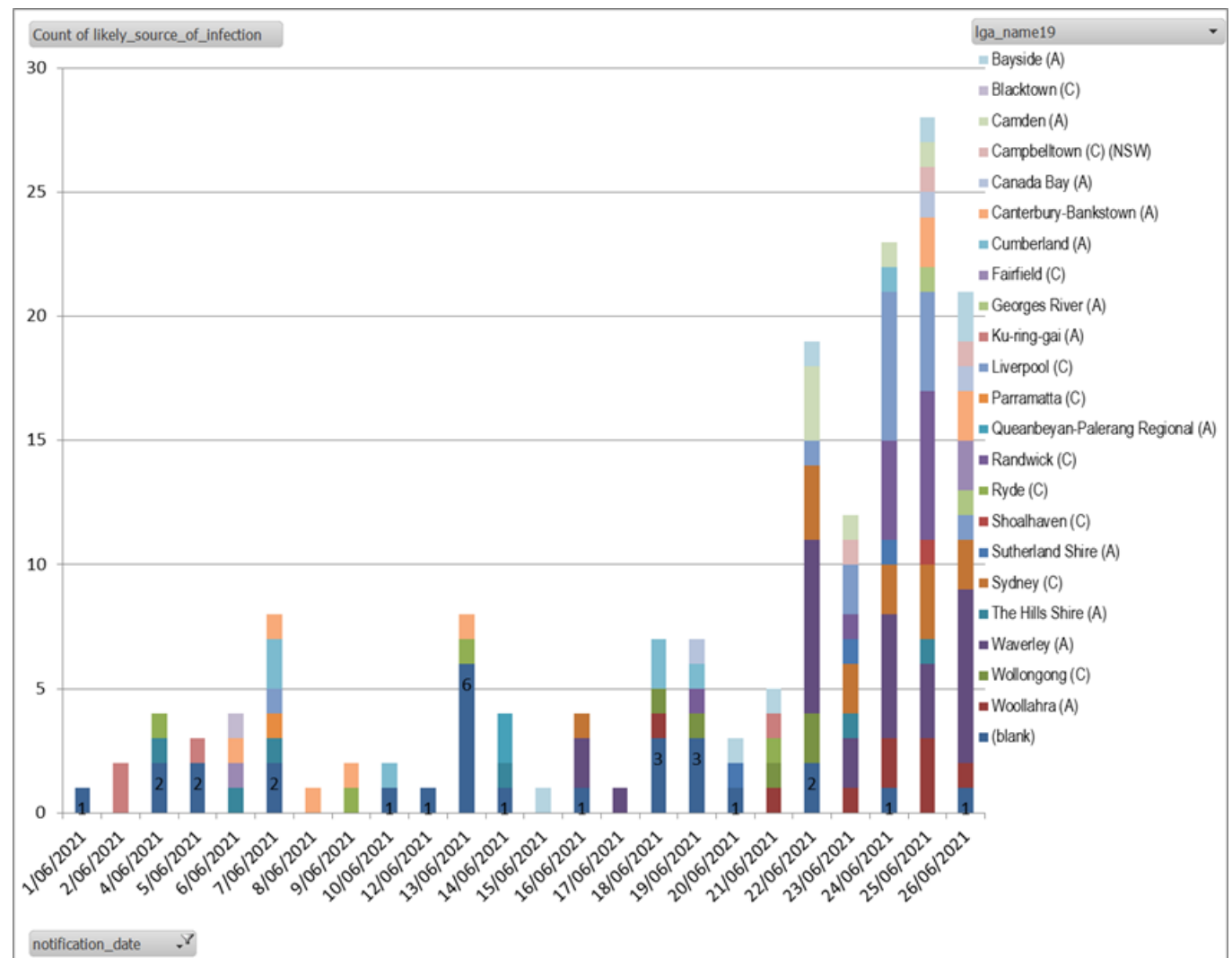


- The current outbreak started on 15th June and has increased exponentially, and it continues to grow

### NSW Cases by Day



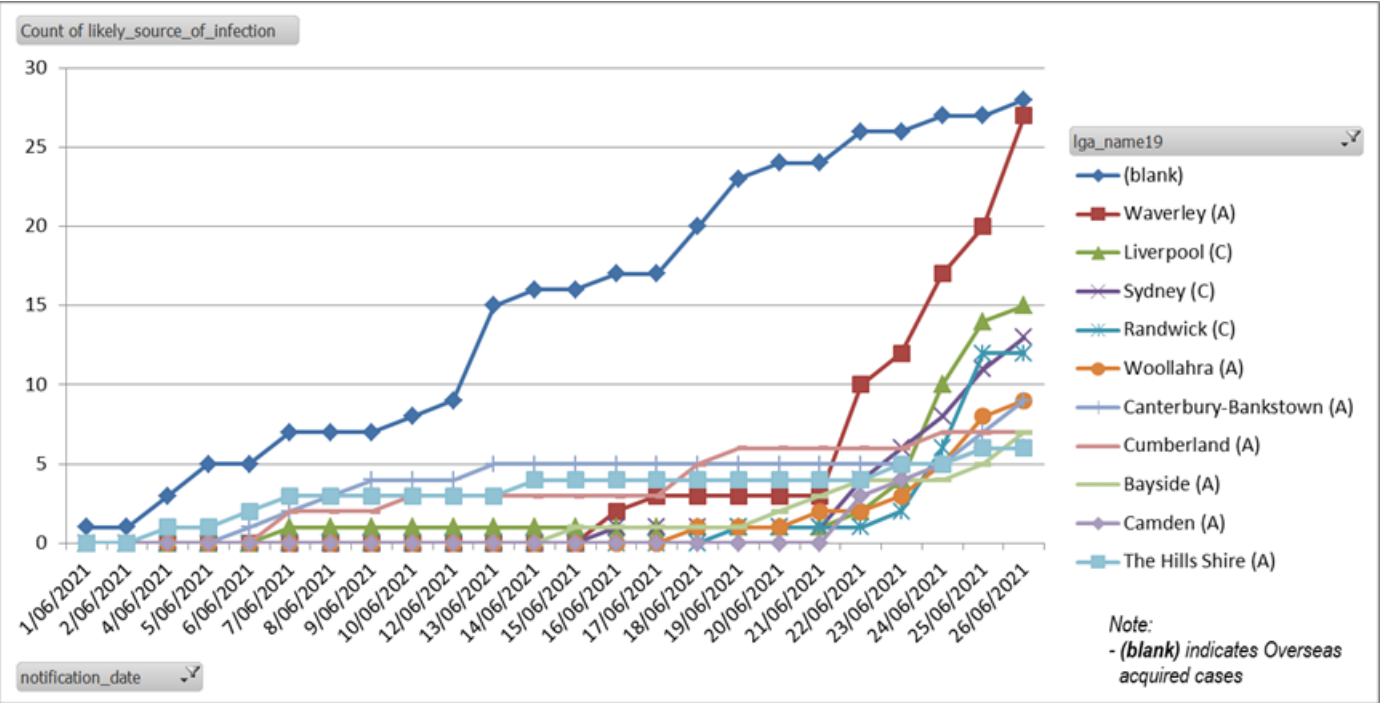

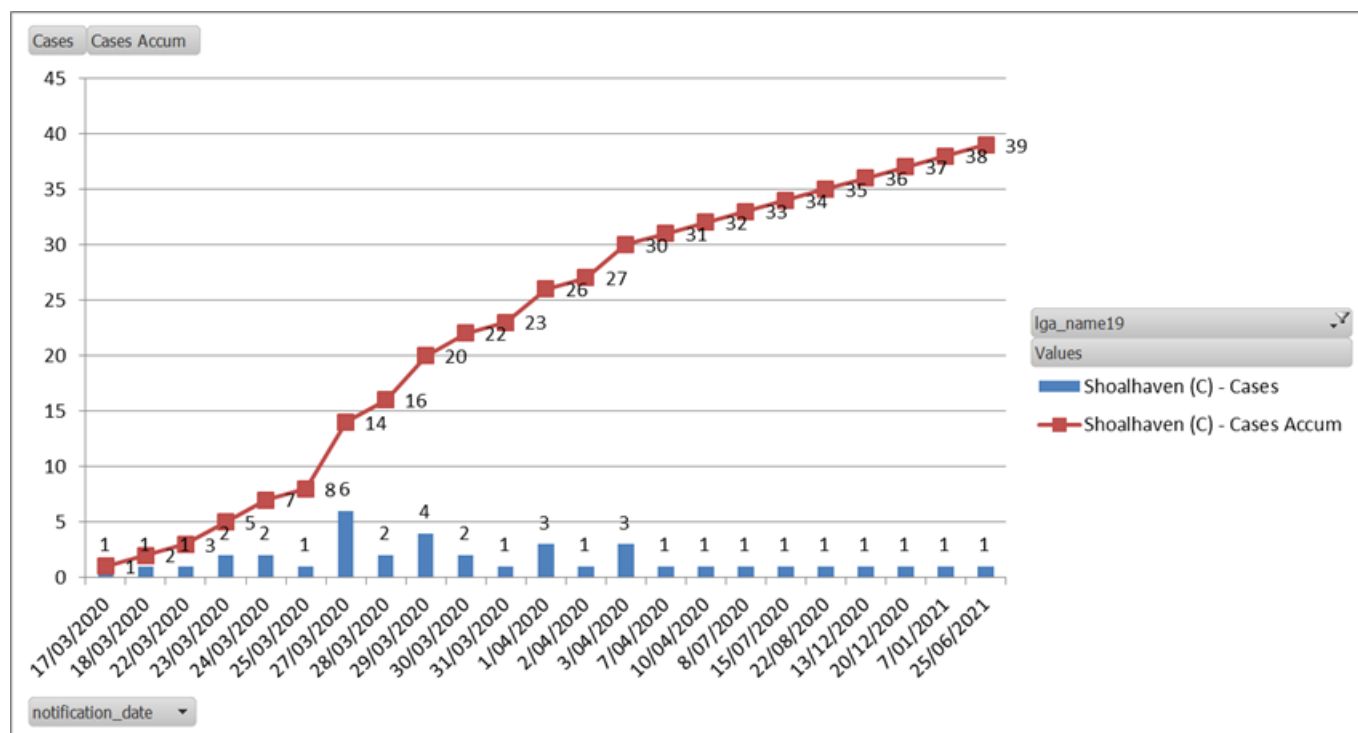
- Cases reported last 4 days from: Waverley 17, Liverpool 13, Randwick 11, Sydney 9, Woollahra 7, Canterbury-Bankstown 4, Camden 3, Bayside 3, Campbelltown 3, The Hills Shire 2, Overseas 2, Georges River 2, Sutherland Shire 2, Canada Bay 2, Fairfield 2, Shoalhaven 1, Cumberland 1.

### NSW Trends of the "Hotspot" LGAs (the areas to avoid!)



- Locally acquired cases make up the majority of the cases in NSW, Waverley alone has almost caught up with the total of Overseas cases
- Shoalhaven has 1 locally acquired case reported on 25th June !!! Please people be careful and follow all COVID protocols !!!**

### SHOALHAVEN Cases



- **One new locally transmitted case reported in the Shoalhaven on 25th June !!! Must be careful guys !!!**
- Last previously reported case in the Shoalhaven LGA was on 7th Jan ; and it was overseas acquired
